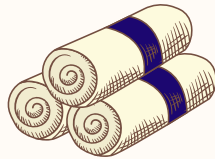

Use a gentle soap and water to wash your wound.

Dry the wound thoroughly with clean, soft cloth by blotting.

Apply Vaseline

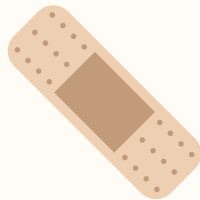

Apply a thick layer of over-the-counter petroleum jelly/Vaseline with a cotton swab. Do not use Antibiotic ointment.

Cover

Cover the wound with a clean bandage.

- Signs of Infection are: Increased pain, swelling, redness or yellowish drainage several days after procedure. If any of these signs appear, please call the office at (520) 771-2088.
